

Mountain Oyster Club Contemporary Western Art Show and Sale

In keeping with the Mountain Oyster Club's long standing commitment to the exhibition and sale of outstanding contemporary Western art, we are inviting you to participate with pieces that you *have created during the last calendar year* for the Fall 2017 Show and Sale. The goal of the Show is to feature the work of both established and new artists who produce artwork of the highest quality.

Artists are reminded of the following requirements:

- Submit no more than five (5) images representing the best and most recent examples of your artwork. All works must be original art or original prints; giclées and lithographs are not eligible. Only original pieces created in 2016-2017 that have not been previously submitted to the jury or exhibited in Tucson, AZ are eligible. Because of space limitations, a selected artist may expect to exhibit up to two pieces.
- Submit enclosed Artist Submission Form with description of artwork, size and price at the time of submission of images,
- Submit images in JPG format at a maximum resolution of 150 dpi, between 1200 x 1600 pixels. Please title each jpg file with your last name, then first name, and lastly the title of the piece. (eg: last name-first name-title)
- Submit an Artist Biography not to exceed 300 words, as well as list of awards, galleries or shows that you exhibit in, and any other pertinent information.
- Submit images of professional quality by September 1, 2017 deadline to be included in the show jury.
- Submit Jury Fee: \$25.00 which may be paid online by requesting an invoice at art@mountainoysterclub.com or by check/money order made out to Mountain Oyster Club. Submissions will not be presented to the Committee for consideration without a jury fee.

Selections will be made by the Mountain Oyster Art Committee in mid-September. Artists will be notified of their selection by Friday, September 29, 2017. Artwork selected for the show must be received by October 20, 2017.

Commission and Payment Procedure

All Show purchases are made by check, so the artist will receive a check payable directly to them from the purchaser for the amount designated on the submission form. The sale is between the artist and the purchaser, so all expenses including framing, shipping, taxes, and commission should be considered when pricing artwork. With your check, you will receive a statement with the amount of commission that is due the Mountain Oyster Club, which is **35%** of the sale price on all sold pieces.

Shipping

Art not sold will be returned to the artist after the show is taken down in mid-January. It will be re-packaged in the container it was received in (when possible) by the carrier of the artist's choice. The artist is responsible for shipping fees and insurance on returned works. The Club will not accept responsibility for damages caused by common carriers in the return of unsold art.
